We share our playground with the other children at lunchtime so you will get to play with your friends from other year groups too.


(Don't worry if it is too busy as you can also play in our special Year R area).



At our school, every class or Key Stage has a special Prayer Station. We can use these to reflect on our thoughts after Worship and R.E. lessons, if we wish to.


We go to Worship each morning with the whole school to learn about our key Christian Values.


