Book Fair – Monday-Thursday after school

The Book Fair will be open on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday of this week from 15:30 – 16:00. It will be accessible through the KS2 corridor entrance from the playground (follow the signs!). Payment can be taken in the following ways:
