## School Uniform in September

From September, children will wear either their school uniform or their PE kit during school days. We will be asking children to wear their PE kit on Forest School days (they will need to wear their winter PE joggers, rather than their shorts so their legs are covered). We have also removed the need for a black hoodie for PE, and we will be asking children to wear their usual school jumper / cardigan on PE days.

Please remember that **children in Years R, 1 and 2 have the choice to wear Active Uniform**. If they choose active uniform, they will only need a house-coloured PE T-Shirt as an addition on PE Days.

## Optional Active Uniform for Years R, 1 and 2:

- \*\* Please note: Children are able to wear our traditional school uniform if they wish to.
- Plain black leggings or jogging bottoms (unbranded) / plain black sports shorts for the summer.
- Plain / Harrietsham emblem (optional) white polo shirt.
- Maroon sweatshirt / cardigan with Harrietsham emblem.
- <u>Plain black</u> trainers / plimsoles / suitable shoes.
- White, black or grey socks.
- Book Bag (Harrietsham emblem optional no ruck-sacks please).

#### PE Kit:

House coloured PE T-Shirt for PE days.













## Traditional Uniform for Years 3, 4, 5 and 6:

- Grey school trousers, long shorts, skirt or pinafore.
- Plain / Harrietsham emblem (optional) white polo shirt.
- Maroon sweatshirt / cardigan with Harrietsham emblem.
- Red and white checked summer dress (optional Terms 1, 5 and 6)
- Plain black school shoes.
- White, black or grey socks or tights.
- Book Bag (Harrietsham emblem optional).

#### PE Kit:

- House coloured PE T-Shirt.
- <u>Plain black</u> sports shorts.
- <u>Plain black</u> leggings / joggers.
- Plain black or white trainers.

















Any items of school uniform with a logo can be purchased from Monkhouse or Brigade.

The only item of uniform that requires a logo is the maroon school jumper / cardigan.

## Planned transition for next year

As we near the end of this school year, we want to take a moment to thank you for your continued support and partnership. Working together with our families is crucial for us to best support your children's learning and development.

As we begin the transition into the next school year, we're already looking ahead with excitement. This period of transition is an important time for the children as it helps them to build confidence, ease into new routines, and feel prepared for the challenges and opportunities of their next class. We are committed to making the upcoming year even more enriching and engaging, and we look forward to continuing this journey together with you and your child.

Please see below for details of the transition programme which we intend to put into place to best support your child:

- Teacher and LSA meeting time to hand over key information about children.
- Pastoral and SEND handovers with the Pastoral and Inclusion teams.
- Transition booklets created for all children (to be sent out later this term).
- Pre-transition, informal visits from new teachers and LSAs for children with specific needs.
- Additional transition opportunities for our current Year R and Year 1 children: For our younger children
  especially, we understand that moving into a new classroom can be a big step, so we will be offering
  some morning and afternoon sessions in their new classes to help them feel comfortable and secure.
- Whole school transition days: Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> July and Friday 11<sup>th</sup> July. For these days, all children will attend their new classes with their new teachers and LSAs. Drop off and pick up will be from the children's new classrooms.
- Open Classrooms for parents to meet new teachers: Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> July.
