School Day in September

The Government advise that every child should be entitled to a minimum of 32.5 hours a week primary education. This equates to 6.5 hours a day. Our school day currently runs 5 minutes short of this requirement each day, which amounts to 25 minutes a week. For this reason, and as per guidance, we are extending our school day by 5 minutes from September 2024.

Our new school day times will be as follows:

Gates Open: 8:30am Gates Close: 8:50am End of Day: 3:20pm

You will see that although we are closing the gates 5 minutes earlier, to meet the Government requirement, the period of time that the gates will remain open will be longer, and so we are hopeful that this will help with traffic outside of school during the morning drop-off.

















School Uniform in September

Thank you to all families who completed our Active Uniform Survey. We have considered all responses and comments. It was clear that with 79% of all entrants voting for active uniform in some of our year groups, this is something that you as families really value. We also can see the benefits of Active Uniform to promote independence and resilience for our younger children.

For this reason, we have decided that from September 2024 all children in Years R, 1 and 2 will have the option to wear Active Uniform. Children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 will need to wear our standard school uniform.

- Maroon sweatshirt / cardigan with Harrietsham emblem.
- Plain black trainers / plimsoles / suitable shoes every day.
- White, black or grey socks.
- Book Bag (Harrietsham emblem optional no ruck-sacks please).

PE Kit:

House coloured PE T-Shirt for PE days.
