


Dear Families and children,

# KEY NFORMATION Does my child need a PE bag in Year 4? No, your child will be able to wear their PE Kit (Plain black joggers / leggings / sports shorts, house coloured t-shirt, plain black trainers and

school jumper / cardigan) to school on their PE Days. These dates will be communicated with you at the beginning of Term 1.

### Will my child still bring home a reading book?

Your child will bring a book home. It remains just as important that your child reads at home to you daily in Year 4.

### Will my child have homework in Year Four?

The children will be asked to read their reading books each day. They will have spellings set each week and can practice these on Spelling Shed, it is important that they practice these to developing their knowledge of spelling patterns. They will continue to use Times Tables Rockstars to develop their knowledge of times tables.

### Will I still be able to speak to my child's teacher informally?

Of course! Your child's teacher will be at the door after school each day and is available for you to speak to. If you need a longer conversation, please let us know.
