CATS and Kent Test
(11+) applications.

CATS are designed for a number of reasons:
teachers can tailor teaching and support; secondary schools may use them to assess a child's potential; they can monitor a child's progress; they can determine the likelihood of being suitable for the Kent Test.

Kent Test (11+) applications usually open in June for 1 month.
The test is usually held in September at the start of Year 6.
Results are usually released in October.

We will be inviting you to attend information evenings regarding CATS and Kent Tests when the time is right!

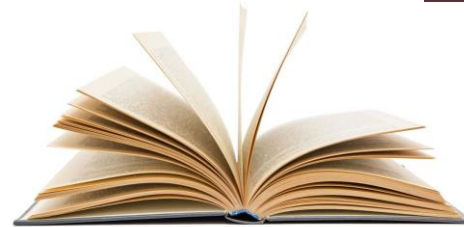
