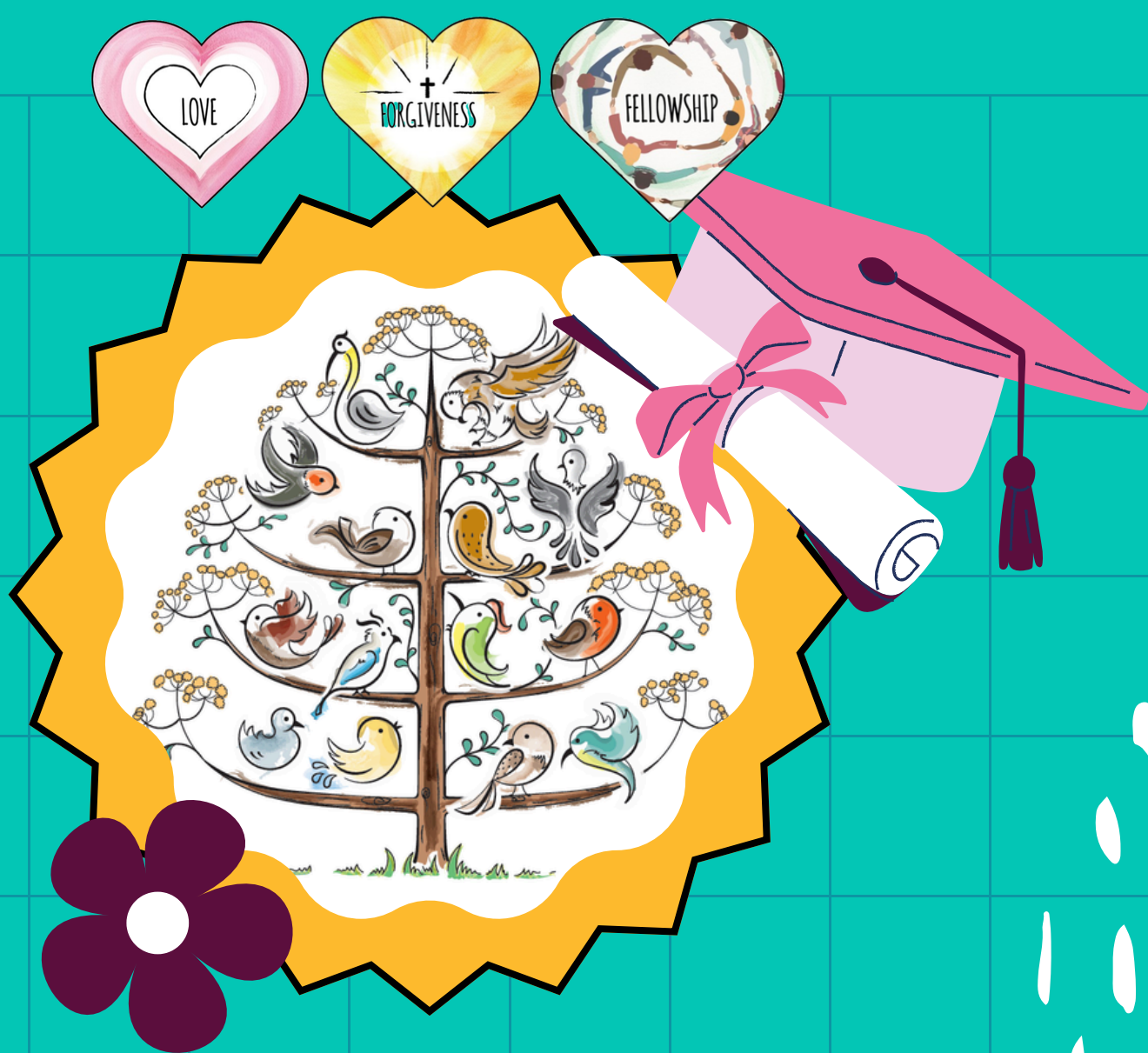




MOVING TO YEAR 6

coming year.



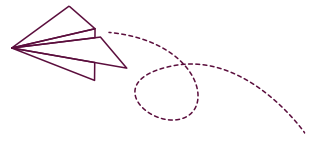
Once my child is in Year 6, does everything change?

WHAT WILL I NEED IN YEAR 6?





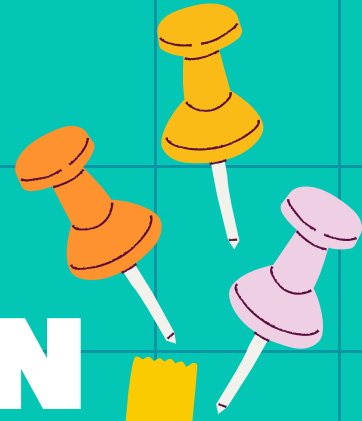


Year 6 children will need to wear our traditional school uniform.

KEY INFORMATION

Does my child need a PE bag in Year 6?

No, your child will be able to wear their PE Kit (plain black joggers / leggings / sports shorts, house coloured t-shirt, plain black trainers and school jumper / cardigan) to school on their PE Days. These dates will be communicated with you at the beginning of Term 1.

Will my child still bring home a reading book?

Your child will bring home a reading book from Accelerated Reader. It remains just as important that your child reads at home to you daily.

Will my child have homework in Year 6?

The children will be asked to read their reading book each day. They will have spellings set each week on Spelling Shed; it is important that they practise these to develop their knowledge of spelling patterns. They will continue to use TTRS to develop their knowledge of times tables. They will be set a weekly Maths and English task and they will continue to be able to complete Home Learning challenges from the termly grid.

Will I still be able to speak to my child's teacher informally?

Of course! Your child's teacher will be at the door after school each day and is available for you to speak to. If you need a longer conversation, please let us know.
