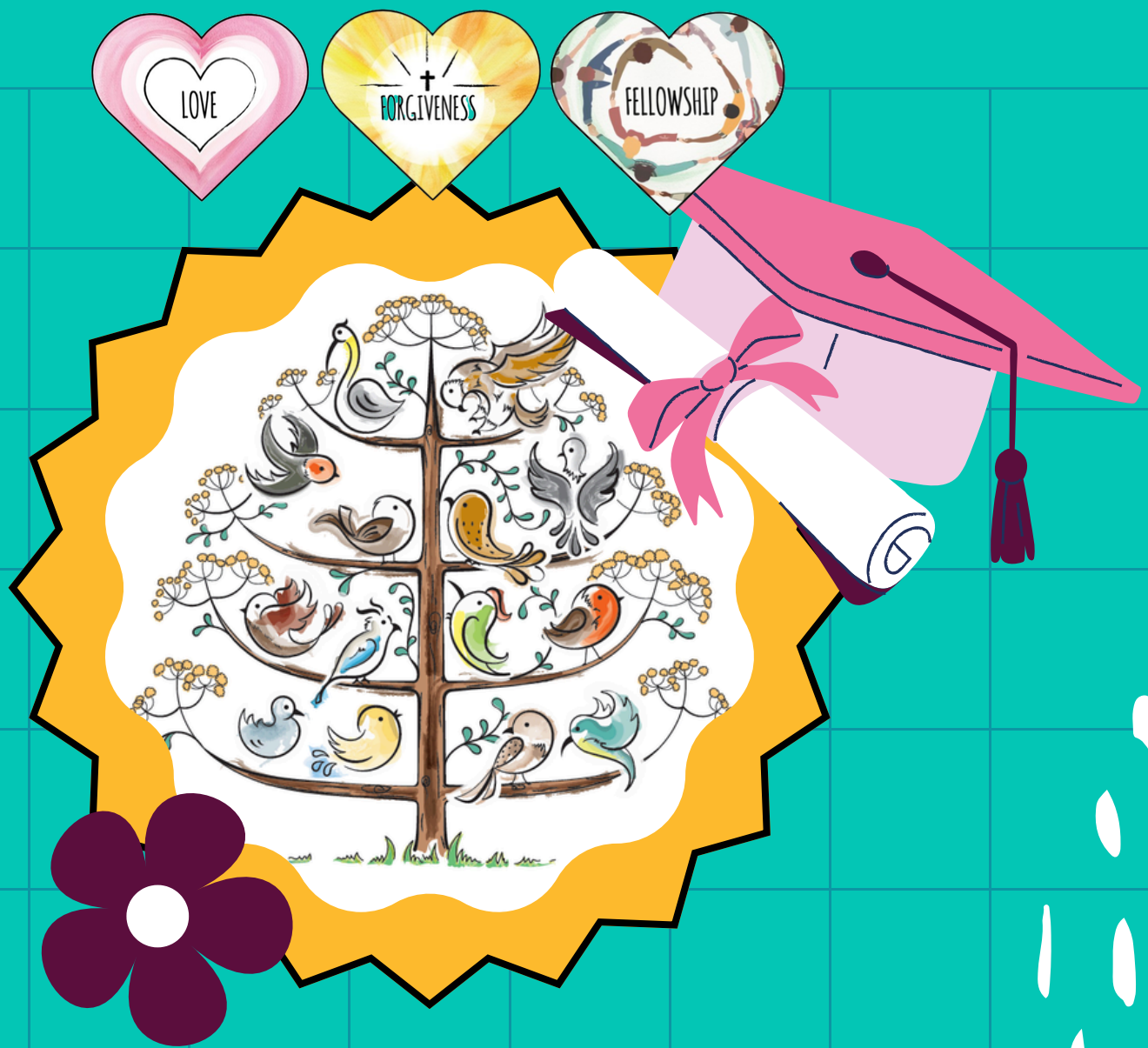




MOVING TO YEAR 2

coming year.



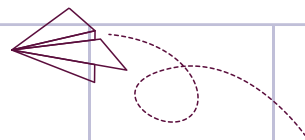
Once my child is in Year 2, does everything change?

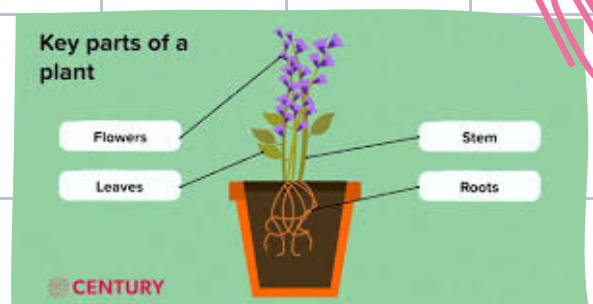
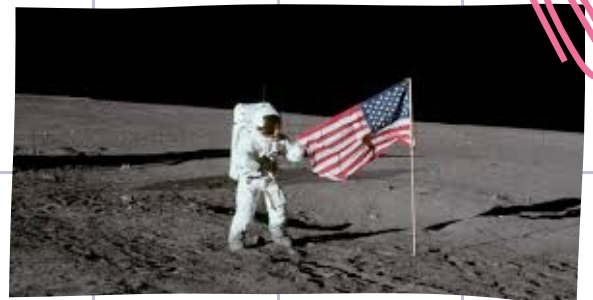
MY CLASSROOMS

KEY INFORMATION

What does my child wear in year 2?

In Year 2, your child can wear Active School Uniform each day if they wish to (<https://www.harrietsham.kent.sch.uk/uniform/>).

Your child will be able to wear their PE Kit (Plain black joggers / leggings / sports shorts, house coloured t-shirt, plain black trainers and school jumper / cardigan) to school on their PE Days. These dates will be communicated with you at the beginning of Term 1.

Will my child still bring home a reading book?

Your child will bring home a reading book just like they did in Year 1. It remains just as important that your child reads at home to you daily in Year 2.

Will my child have homework in Year 2?

The children will be asked to read their reading books each day to you. They will have spellings set each week on Spelling Shed to learn. It is important that they complete these activities so that they develop their knowledge of spelling patterns. They will continue to be asked to complete Numbots daily to develop their knowledge of times tables and they will be set a weekly letter formation task. They will also be asked to complete Home Learning challenges from the termly grid.

Will I still be able to speak to my child's teacher informally?

Of course! Your child's teacher will be at the door before and after school each day and is available for you to speak to. If you need a longer conversation, please let us know.
