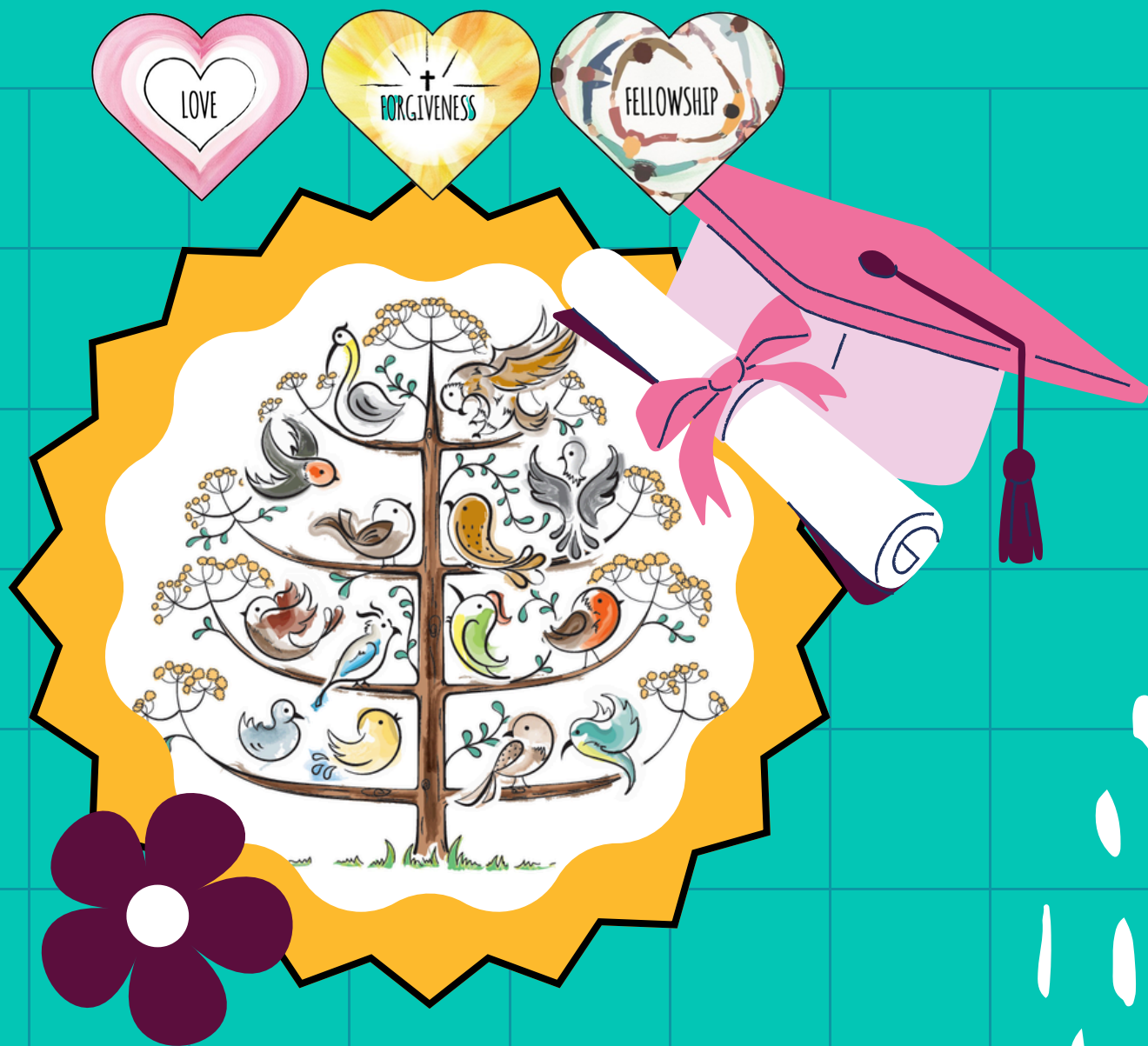




MOVING TO YEAR 5

expect in September.



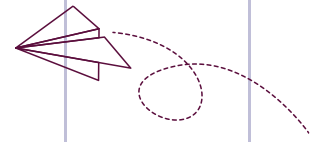
Once my child is in Year 5, does everything change?

KEY INFORMATION

Does my child need a PE bag in Year 5?

No, your child will be able to wear their PE Kit (Plain black joggers / leggings / sports shorts, house coloured t-shirt, plain black trainers and school jumper / cardigan) to school on their PE Days. These dates will be communicated with you at the beginning of Term 1.

Will my child still bring home a reading book?

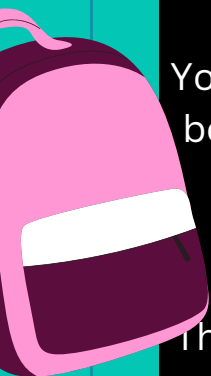
Your child will bring home an Accelerated Reader book and a love to read book from the Library. It remains just as important that your child reads at home to you daily in Year 5.

Will my child have homework in Year 5?

The children will be asked to read their reading books each day. They will have spellings set each week and they can practise these on Spelling Shed. It is important that they practise these to develop their knowledge of spelling patterns. They will have a piece of Maths and English per week and the option to complete a weekly home learning challenge from the termly grid. They will continue to use Times Tables Rockstars to develop their knowledge of times tables. Children can focus on particular Maths skills using Mathletics.

Will I still be able to speak to my child's teacher informally?

Of course! Your child's teacher will be at the door after school each day and is available for you to speak to. If you need a longer conversation, please let us know.
