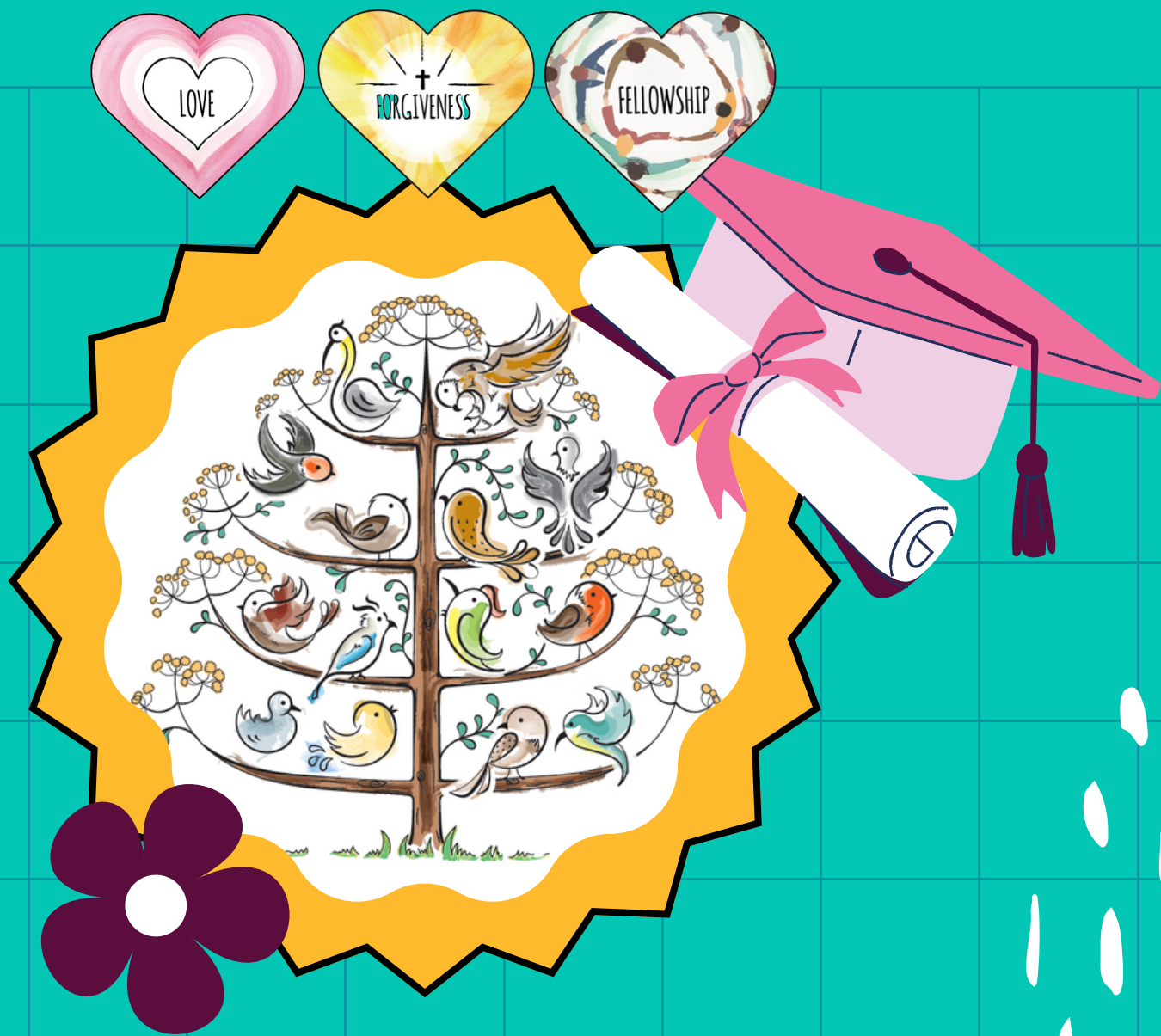




MOVING TO YEAR 3

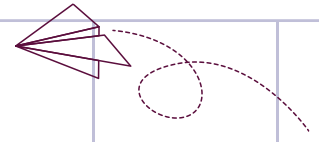
Once my child is in Year 3, does everything change?

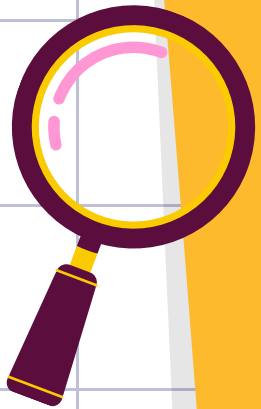

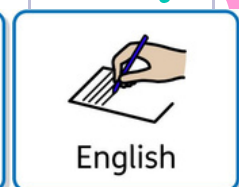
A TYPICAL SCHOOL DAY

Year Three:

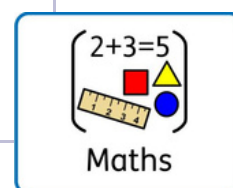
In the morning, we will start our day with Early Morning Work, just like in Year 2. Then we will have Reading and Maths before break. After break time, we will have English and Mastering Number.

KEY INFORMATION

Does my child need a PE bag in Year 3?

your child will be able to wear their PE Kit (Plain black joggers / leggings / sports shorts, house coloured t-shirt, plain black trainers and school jumper / cardigan) to school on their PE Days. These dates will be communicated with you at the beginning of Term 1.

Will my child still bring home a reading book?

Your child will bring home a banded reading book every day from Accelerated Reader. It remains just as important that your child reads at home to you daily in Year 3.

Will my child have homework in Year 3?

The children will be asked to read their reading books each day. They will continue using Accelerated Reader. They will have spellings set each week on Spelling Shed; it is important that they learn these to develop their knowledge of spelling patterns. The children will also use Times Tables Rock Stars to develop their knowledge of times tables. In addition, there will be a weekly English or Maths task for the children to cement their learning in class. They will also still be able to choose from the activities on the termly Topic Tasks Menu.

Will I still be able to speak to my child's teacher informally?

Of course! Your child's teacher will be at the door after school each day and is available for you to speak to. If you need a longer conversation, please let us know.
