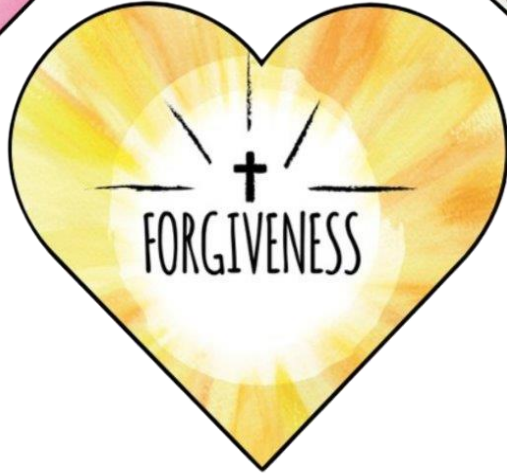

Forest school will be on alternate weeks, the same as last year.**

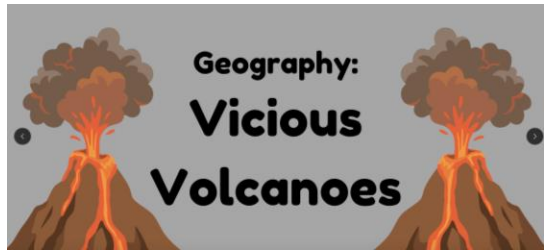
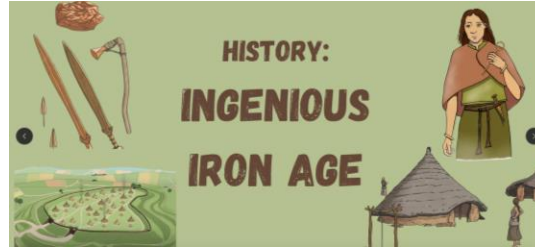

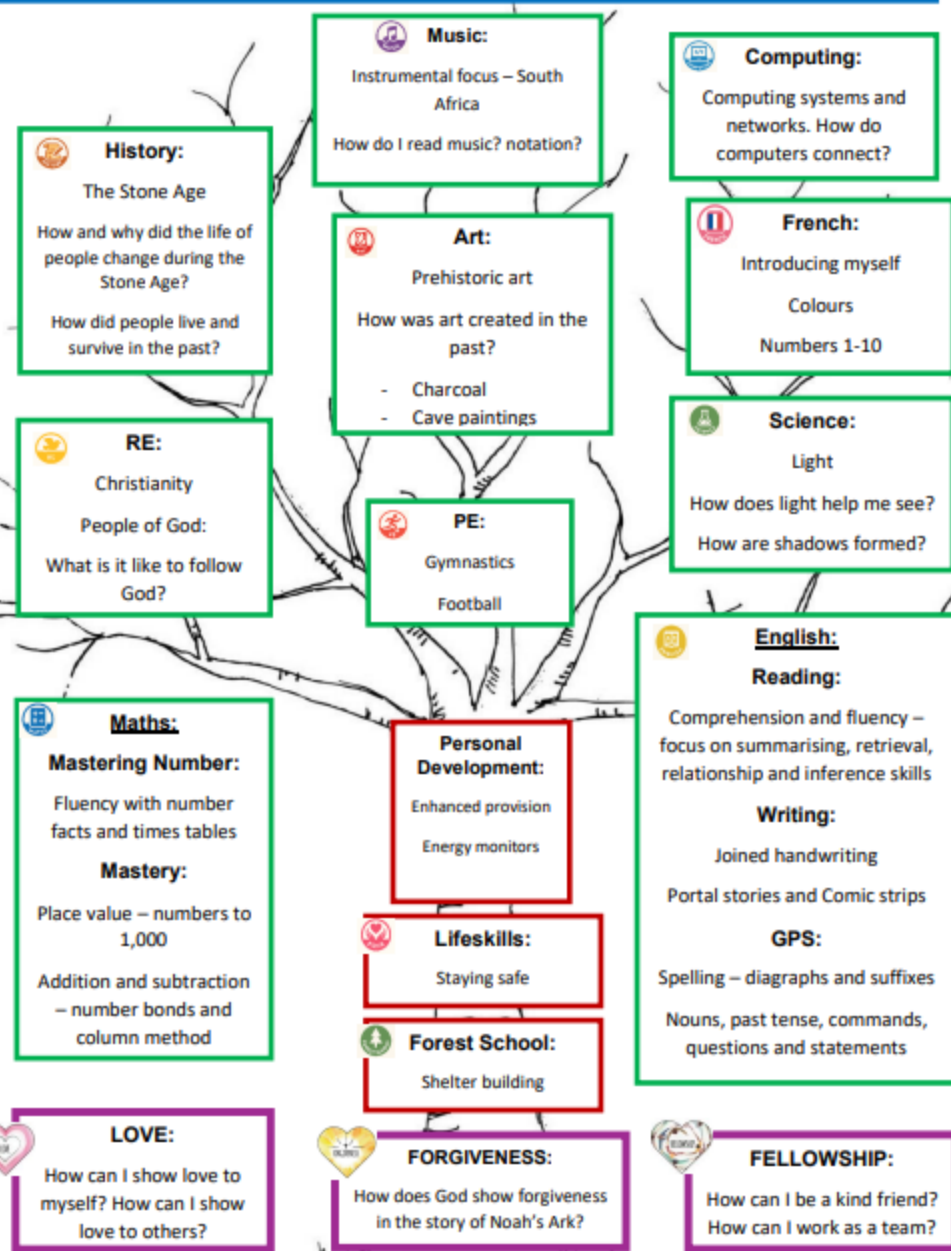

Reading at school

Children have daily whole class reading sessions in which we focus upon different essential reading skills.



Read around the target word to see how it is being used in the text.



Touch the answer in the text before you fish it out.



Find and talk about the text's main points.



Use clues from the text and your own ideas to work out the answer.



Decide what is most likely to happen next in the text.



Talk about the structure of the text.



Talk about the effect of words and groups of words used in the text.



Compare the events, characters and structure of the text.

Remember

- Read the whole question carefully.
- Find the key words in the question.
- Look for key words from the question in the text.
- Check that your answer matches the question.

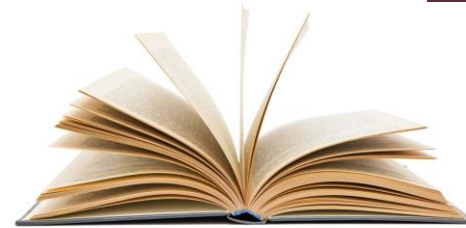
